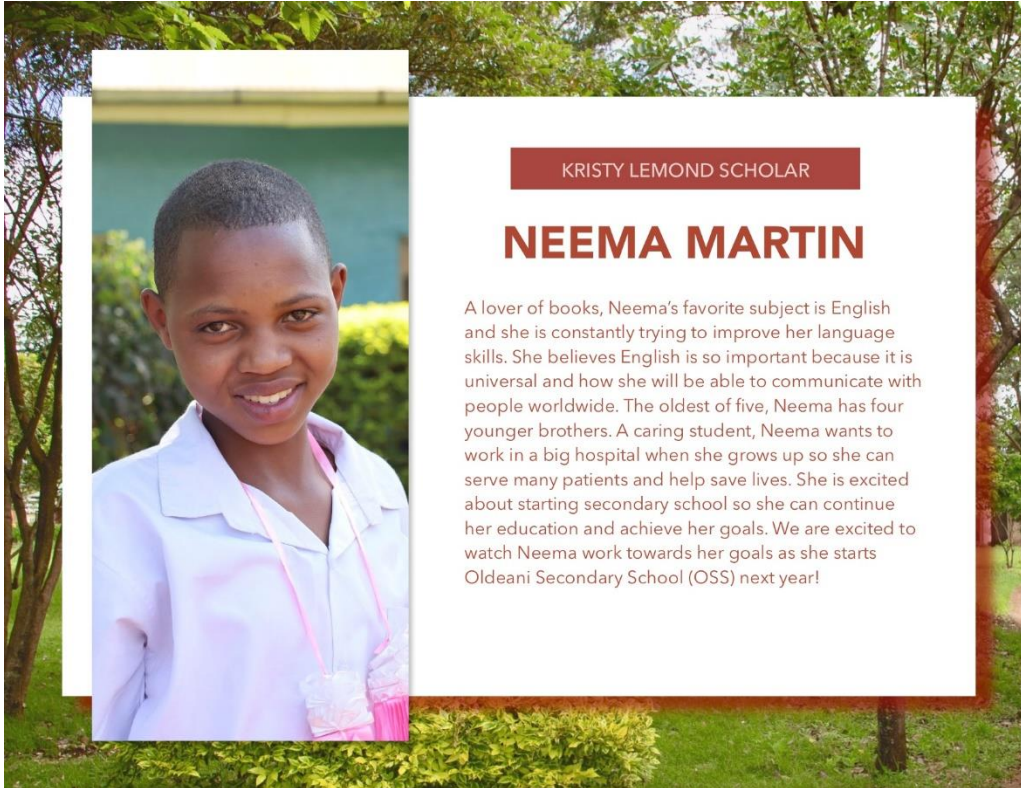




KRISTY LEMOND SCHOLAR
